



Mill House Pond

Mill House Pond is situated in Earl Soham as part of a smallholding run by Giles and Jackie Barrow. The pond has recently been renovated and freshly stocked and provides a good range of mixed coarse fish.

Fishing

Although the pond is relatively small it is well stocked with roach and rudd and these provide easy catches for beginners and children keen to get bites. There are also young tench, bream and perch for those more canny anglers, but the more advanced visitors may want to try for the larger stock; carp from 3 – 9lb and tench up to 4lb.

A limited range of fishing equipment is available if you do not have your own. Bait is occasionally available but be prepared to bring your own. In either case, ring ahead to check out what we've got.



Getting there from Alde Garden campsite

Earl Soham is just 8 miles from the campsite and the journey takes approximately 15 minutes. Take the B1119 towards Framlingham and then onto Saxtead Green to pick up on the A1120 toward Stowmarket. As you come

through Earl Soham the road passes the Victoria Pub before turning sharp left and then goes uphill. The Mill House Pond is in the field on the right hand side of the road almost at the top of the hill, opposite the main house. Parking is at the layby at the entrance of the field, or if need be, in the yard outside the house

on the left hand drive. We have toilets available in our top field on the opposite side of the road from the pond.

Expectations

The pond is on a private smallholding. We are **not** a commercial fishery. Please leave no litter, keep gates closed and use barbless hooks. Larger fish must be landed with a net and keep nets are not allowed. The pond is about 4 feet deep: children need to be accompanied. **Do not** fish on the far side of the pond as there are overhead cables. The island is out of bounds!
